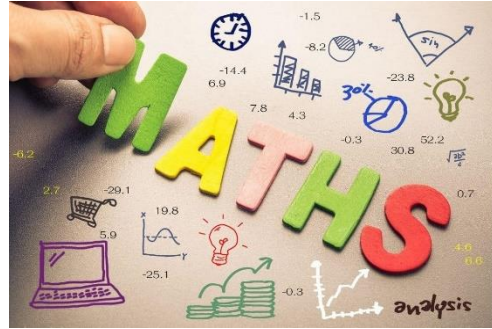


There are numerous math's resources and games online to support learning and make learning more fun, below are just a few. They include recommendations made by children in year 4.
