

The parents/carers will aim to:

- ensure their child wears correct school uniform/school PE kit as required
- collect their child punctually and inform school of any changes to pick up arrangements at the end of the day
- encourage positive behaviour choices in line with our school rules, 'Be Ready, Respectful, Responsible'

- encourage their child's learning in all areas of school life
- support the school ethos and ways of working
- attend parent consultation meetings and support school activities wherever possible
- follow school policy and procedures relating to the use of the internet and social media
- ensure careful and considerate parking and driving in the vicinity of the school
- behave safely, politely and respectfully when on school premises
